

Permission: Use of Physical Restraint

The Massachusetts Department of Elementary & Secondary Education requires that Oxford Public Schools and Project COFFEE seek permission from parents and guardians for the use of physical restraint when, in extreme circumstances, students pose a threat of imminent serious harm to himself or herself or others. The use of restraint is dictated and governed by Massachusetts Department of Elementary & Secondary Regulations, 603 CMR 46.00.

In recognition of these state requirements, I give permission for the Oxford Public Schools and Project COFFEE to use physical restraint only when my child poses a threat of imminent serious harm to himself or herself or others and when other non-physical interventions have failed or been deemed inappropriate.

This permission shall be valid for the current academic year.
